Free and open to the public, Baltimore Book Festival is the premier celebration of literary arts in the mid-Atlantic region, the Festival welcomed more than 45,000 visitors who spent over \$1.27 million with the festival's exhibitors and vendors in 2012.

**New** for 2013, **Book Arts** at the festival seeks to highlight artists, businesses and organizations whose work and craft (graphic design, illustration, printmaking, etc.), pertain to the bookmaking and book preserving arts. If you specialize in contemporary and traditional artistic practices related to the book as an art object, this is the place to feature your work.

Paper Making/Engineering

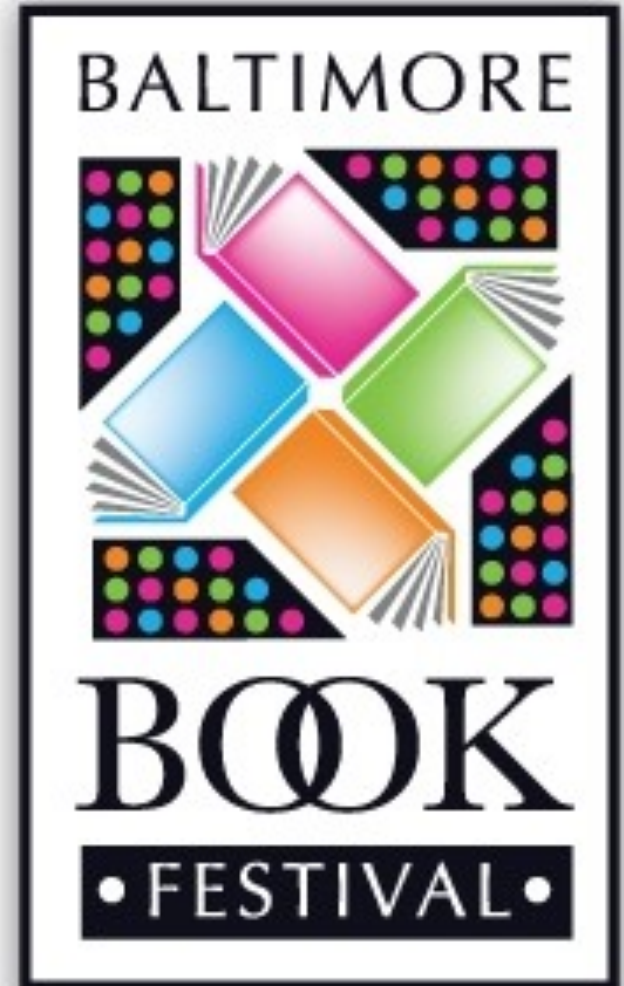
